Boerne ISD families:

Thank you to everyone who took the time to be informed about Boerne ISD's 2016 bond and who came out to vote in Saturday's election.

The election results illustrated once again how deeply our community values public education. Voters in Boerne, Fair Oaks Ranch and surrounding neighborhoods approved the bond proposal by a margin of 73 percent to 27 percent. This was an important day in the life of the district, equipping us to meet the challenges of continued enrollment growth.

With the passage of the bond, work will begin almost immediately on some of the measures that have been funded. Site work on the new Elementary School No. 6 on Dietz Elkhorn will commence shortly. As the school year wraps up and the team at Fabra moves to its new campus, work to convert the old site to the district's administrative center will begin. The search for a site to become the home of our third middle school will intensify in coming weeks.
